

# TRYING HARD TO BE HAPPY: DOES FORCING POSITIVITY CREATE THE OPPOSITE?

In our culture, there is often a message that "thinking positive" is all we need in life to be happy and well, and that states of unhappiness or unwellness are in our own mind-control. We'll see a brief video with Harvard psychologist Susan David, who argues that forcing "positivity" can actually lessen, rather than strengthen, our emotional resilience for life's challenges.
