LIGHTING OF THE THIRD ADVENT CANDLE: JOY

Today we light the third candle of Advent, as we remember the first candle, for hope, and the second, for peace.

Today the light increases: *hope* and *peace* add *joy.* Through the church's long tradition of Advent, the pink candle on the third Sunday reminds us that in the midst of our waiting,

joy is already visible, we glimpse it ahead of time. We remember that even in times of uncertainty, worry or struggle,


God's joy can find us.
